2025 performance audit and asset management system review

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the 2025 <u>performance audit</u> and <u>asset management system review</u> reports and the <u>post-audit implementation plan</u> for WR Carpenter No. 1 Pty Ltd's electricity generation licence EGL20.

WR Carpenter operates a multi-fuel cogeneration power station at the South32 Worsley Alumina Pty Ltd refinery, located near Collie, approximately 170 kilometres south of Perth. The 104-megawatt power station supplies electricity and steam to the Worsley refinery to produce alumina. Surplus electricity is exported to the South West Interconnected System.

The ERA considers that WR Carpenter has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence and has an effective asset management system.

The ERA has decided to maintain the audit and review period at 60 months. The next audit and review will cover the period 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2030, with the report due to be provided by 31 July 2030.

Audit and review findings

The audit found two minor administrative non-compliances for paying licence fees and charges late and submitting an incomplete annual compliance report to the ERA.

The review found that WR Carpenter has an effective asset management system with no deficiencies.
