Licence renewal application – invitation for submissions

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Shell Energy Retail Pty Ltd's application to renew its <u>electricity retail licence ERL15</u> which is due to expire on 14 October 2025. The ERA is considering renewing the licence for 15 years.

ERL15 authorises Shell Energy to sell electricity to large use customers in the South West Interconnected System. Shell Energy does not sell electricity to residential customers.

The renewal of a licence is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it will not be contrary to the public interest to do so, and that the applicant has and is likely to retain or will acquire within a reasonable time after the renewal and is then likely to retain, the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

When considering the renewal application, the ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the renewal application.

Submissions close 4:00pm (WST) Tuesday, 2 September 2025.
