Good Afternoon

Thank you for the opportunity to provide this submission on the Limit Advice and Constraint Equation Review Draft Report. Perth Energy is a significant player within the SWIS electricity system as a major retailer, a power station owner and new plant developer. As such, we are keen to see the market continue to develop in line with the Government's State electricity objective balancing reliability, affordability and sustainability.

The successful implementation and operation of constrained access to the transmission system is a key element in achieving this. It is therefore pleasing that the ERA has concluded that the processes within both organisations are robust and internally transparent. We note, however, that the level of internal documentation available to staff varies in quality and quantity between both organisations and has been flagged as an area for improvement.

We strongly support the recommendation to update and expand public procedures to include more information to support less technical stakeholders. This, along with increasing the transparency around RCM processes, and how limits and constraints fit within the RCM framework, will significantly help investors gain a better understanding of the constraint process. We see this as particularly important to facilitate the addition of new generation facilities to replace existing plant which is likely to be closed over the next few years.

Perth Energy also supports continuing the roll out of dynamic thermal line ratings across the network but acknowledge that this may take several years.
