

## NOTICE

### PRODUCTION OF INFORMATION ACCESS ARRANGEMENT PROPOSED BY WESTERN POWER FOR THE SOUTH WEST INTERCONNECTED NETWORK

The Economic Regulation Authority (Authority) has today issued a notice to Western Power Corporation (Western Power) pursuant to section 51 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*. Western Power is required to give specified information or documents that may assist the Authority in relation to the assessment of Western Power's proposed Access Arrangement and access arrangement information for its South West Interconnected Network (SWIN) in the South West Interconnected System.

The Authority has required Western Power to give the information or documents sought by 4:00pm WST, Friday 18 November 2005.

Pursuant to section 4.68 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*, the Authority suspends the operation of the deadline for the issue of a draft decision. A further notice will be published when the Authority restarts the relevant deadline.

Interested parties are informed that the issuing of the section 51 notice referred to above does not affect the closing date for submissions on Western Power's proposed Access Arrangement and access arrangement information, which remains 4:00pm WST, Thursday 10 November 2005.
