The Economic Regulation Authority invites nominations from persons interested in serving on the Electricity Code Consultative Committee.

The Economic Regulation Authority is the independent regulatory and licensing body for the electricity, gas, water and rail industries in Western Australia.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the Economic Regulation Authority is responsible for the review and approval of the *Code of Conduct (for the supply of electricity to small use customers)*.

Nominations are sought from people with relevant qualifications, skills or experience in the energy industry or consumer protection area for the following positions:

- 2 x Representatives from Consumer Organisations (one of these representatives preferably from a regional, rural or remote area).
- 2 x Representatives from the Energy Industry or Energy Industry Representative Organisations

Sitting fees and travel re-imbusement may be paid, the amount of which will be determined by the Authority after advice from the Minister for Public Sector Management.

Appointments are for an initial period of 18 months.
