Extension of Time to Assess the Proposed Revisions to the Access Arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline

The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) has extended the assessment period for the proposed revisions to the Access Arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (**DBNGP**) by a further two months, to 21 November 2005.

A requirement of the *National Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipeline Systems* (**Code**) is that the assessment period for proposed revisions to an Access Arrangement needs to be extended by periods of up to two months after an initial period of six months has elapsed.

As the proposed revisions to the Access Arrangement for the DBNGP were submitted on 21 January 2005 by DBNGP (WA) Transmission Pty Ltd, there is a need for a further two month extension, taking the assessment period to 21 November 2005. This extension is granted pursuant to section 2.44 of the Code.

The Authority expects to issue its Final Decision shortly.
