NOTICE

EXTENSIONS OF TIME

This is to advise that the periods for assessment of the proposed Access Arrangements for the pipelines listed below have been extended. Sections 2.21 and 2.22 of the National Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipeline Systems require that the period for assessing a proposed Access Arrangement be explicitly extended by up to 2 months on one or more occasions if the total period of assessment exceeds 6 months.

The Draft or Final Decisions for the pipelines in question are at various stages of preparation and will be issued as soon as reasonably possible.

The pipelines for which the assessment period has been extended are as follows:

- Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (licence number WA: PL 40) to 15 December 2000.
- Goldfields Gas Pipeline (licence number WA: PL 24) to 15 December 2000.
- Tubridgi Pipeline System (licence numbers WA: PL 16 and 19) to 21 December 2000.

These extensions of time are pursuant to section 2.22 of the Code.
