**Proposed Access Arrangement
Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (DBNGP)**

In section 7.2 “Key Performance Measures for Pipelines” of the proposed Access Arrangement Information for the DBNGP, Table 7.1 “Comparison of Australian Pipelines” illustrates a graphical comparison of tariffs for various Australian pipelines on a cents per 100km basis.

In the table there are references made to AGL pipeline tariffs as being “new” and “existing”, which we understand refers to our Roma to Brisbane Pipeline (RBP). If this is the case the information presented is partially incorrect.

Whilst we have no objection to our publicly available tariff information being referred to in public documents, we do endeavour to have such information accurately quoted. Assuming that the tariff information does relate to the RBP then the correct information as at 1 January 2000, on a 100% load factor basis, is detailed in the table below.

RBP Capacity	Cents per 100km
Existing:0-78TJ per day	8.5
New:78-101TJ per day	17.4

We request that in its decision on the DBNGP access arrangement, that the Regulator requires this apparent error to be rectified.
