EXTENSION OF TIME FOR PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS DRAFT DECISION ON THE PARMELIA PIPELINE ACCESS ARRANGEMENT

This is to advise that an extension of time has been granted to allow additional time for interested parties to make submissions on the Draft Decision for the proposed Access Arrangement for the Parmelia Pipeline (Licence Numbers WA:PLs 1-3, 5 & 23).

This extension of time for submissions is for a period of 13 days until 4 pm Thursday 25 November 1999 Western Standard Time and is granted in accordance with section 7.19 of the *National Third Party Access Code for Natural Gas Pipeline Systems*.

The Draft Decision presents the Regulator's decision and reasons for the decision in respect to the proposed Access Arrangement.

The Draft Decision was completed and placed on the Office of Gas Access Regulation's web site on 27 October 1999. The original Notice calling for public submissions was placed on the OffGAR web site (www.offgar.wa.gov.au) on the same day.

Confidentiality

In general, all submissions from interested parties will be treated as in the public domain and placed on the OffGAR web site. Where an interested party wishes to keep part or all of the contents of a submission confidential, it should indicate these parts clearly. However, where the information is not considered to be 'unduly harmful' to the legitimate business interests of any party, the submission may be returned to the party making the submission with the option of revising or withdrawing it.
