- 1. WMC Resources Ltd is a party to these proceedings and may be referred to as the first respondent.
- 2. Newmont Australia Limited is a party to these proceedings and may be referred to as the second respondent.

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- 3. At the request of the applicant the Presiding Member shall sign a summons on behalf of the Board requiring the Minister to produce before the Board all books, papers and documents available to the Minister in respect of the decision made by the Minister on 2 July 2004.
- 4. On or before 11 February 2005 the National Competition Council ("NCC") shall assemble and produce to the Registrar of the Board copies of all materials available to the NCC in respect of the final recommendation made by it to the Minister in November 2003 and serve on each party an index of those documents identifying any document in respect of which the originator requested confidentiality ("NCC Index").
- 5. Within 14 days of a request by a party for a copy of any document in the NCC Index, the NCC is to provide a copy of the document to the party making the request, unless the originator of the document maintains a claim of confidentiality in respect of the document.
- 6. At the request of any party, the Registrar shall provide to that party a copy of any document produced to the Board pursuant to directions 3 and 4 above subject to payment of the Board's reasonable costs of providing a copy of the document requested, unless the Registrar has reason to believe that the originator of the document maintains a claim of confidentiality in respect of the document.
- 7. On or before 25 February 2005, the applicants shall file and serve a statement of issues, facts and contentions in relation to these proceedings.
- 8. On or before 11 March 2005, the first and second respondents shall file and serve a statement of issues, facts and contentions in response.
- 9. On or before 25 March 2005, the NCC may file and serve a statement of issues, facts and contentions.
- 10. On or before 1 April 2005, the applicants may file and serve a statement of issues, facts and contentions in reply (if any).
- 11. Until further direction, any documents provided by the Minister or the NCC pursuant to directions 3 and 4 above which, or portions of which, are claimed to be confidential, shall, subject to any agreement between the person claiming confidentiality and the person making the request, be kept wholly or partially confidential, as the case may be.
- 12. The parties are to confer and, if possible, file an agreed minute of proposed programming directions for the next stage of the proceedings. If agreement is not reached by 31 March 2005, then the parties are to file and serve their own minutes of proposed directions by 4 April 2005.
- 13. The parties are to provide four hard copies and one electronic copy of any documents, including witness statements and other evidentiary materials,
