During the short submission period we have accessed the submission supplied by Western Power concerning the above. We have also had an opportunity to view the submission made by The Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA) the peak body for L.G.A.'s in Western Australia.

We concur and support the submission made by WALGA and would add that we share their concerns especially the area covering developers "banked" capacity.

If Western Power is allowed to unilaterally reduce capacity of users not using their contracted capacity, priority access should be offered to these users, who may be disadvantaged in the future as a result of having their capacity curtailed.
