

NOTICE

Submissions Received on Matters Relating to Western Power's Revised Proposed Access Arrangement for the South West Interconnected Network

On 17 January 2007 the Economic Regulation Authority published a Notice calling for submissions on three matters:

1. a proposed provision (under the standard access contract for reference services) that will allow Western Power to unilaterally determine to reduce a network user's contracted capacity at a connection point;
2. the treatment of capital contributions under the proposed access arrangement; and
3. the ability of Western Power to require payment of capital contributions in the nature of "headworks" charges.

The deadline for submissions closed on Thursday 8 February 2007 and the submissions received are available on the Authority's [web site](#).

The Authority will take the matters raised therein into consideration in making its Final Decision.
