EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY WITH RING FENCING OBLIGATIONS FOR PARMELIA GAS PIPELINE LICENCE NUMBERS WA: PL 1-3, 5 & 23

This is to advise that in accordance with section 7.19 of the National Third Party Access Code for National Gas Pipeline Systems (the Code), I have granted an extension of time to comply with ring fencing obligations for the Parmelia Pipeline.

CMS Gas Transmission Australia (CMS) has sought an interim extension of time to comply with the ring fencing obligations contained in section 4.1 of the Code to enable further and ongoing dialogue on this matter. The Code specifies compliance within six months of a pipeline being covered, which is 9 August 1999 for this pipeline. The Access Arrangement for the pipeline is currently being assessed.

I consider that under the circumstances a four-week extension until 6 September 1999 is appropriate.
