Background

Under the *Disability Services Act 1993*, the Economic Regulation Authority is required to develop a DAIP. The DAIP is required to outline the Authority's strategies to address each of the following desired outcomes:

- 1) People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to access the services of, and any events organised by, a public authority.
- 2) People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to access the buildings and other facilities of a public authority.
- 3) People with disabilities receive information from a public authority in a format that will enable them to access the information as readily as other people are able to access it.
- 4) People with disabilities receive the same level and quality of service from the staff of a public authority as other people receive from the staff of that public authority.
- 5) People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to make complaints to a public authority.
- 6) People with disabilities have the same opportunities as other people to participate in any public consultation by a public authority.

In accordance with the *Disability Services Regulations 2004*, the Authority invited submissions from interested parties on its draft DAIP from 6 June to 4 July 2007. The Authority received no submissions as a result of this call for public submissions.
