## AMENDMENTS TO LICENCE EIRL 2

Horizon Power requests that licence EIRL 2 be amended to record the licence boundary changes specified below.

Planned Works - Halls Creek

A revision to the licence area in Halls Creek following an application from Indigenous Training WA (ITWA) to supply a training facility to be constructed at Burkes Park. Horizon Power will own the proposed network infrastructure and retail electricity.

Discussions with Authority - Derby/Broome/Karratha/Meekatharra

In all of the following areas Horizon Power's licence area ended at the end of our network infrastructure however, metering of electricity occurred at the end of third party owned assets. Following discussions with the Authority, Horizon Power has amended our licence area maps to align with the request from the Authority these areas be included.

- amendment to the Derby region to include a meter point on the town jetty;
- amendment to the Broome region to include a meter point at Broome Port;
- amendment to the Karratha region to include the meter point at the Radio Tower; and
- amendment to the Meekatharra region to include the meter point at the airport.

## Periodic Audit - Camballin/Mount Magnet/Derby/Exmouth/Pilbara

Horizon Power has instigated a periodic audit to ensure all Horizon Power's infrastructure is contained within its licence areas. The following maps require updating where infrastructure has been identified as falling outside current boundaries:

- amendment to the licence area for the Camballin region to include network infrastructure connecting the independent power producer power station;
- amendment to the licence area for the Mount Magnet region to include network infrastructure connecting to the airport;
- amendments in the Pilbara: to the licence area for Port Hedland to include the Pretty Pool sub-division stage 4, South Hedland to include network infrastructure connecting to the Fortesque Metals Group facilities, Karratha to include the Nickol precinct sub-division, the Pluto facilities and the Oceanic facility;
- amendment to the licence area for the Derby region as maintenance on the distribution line supplying the airport required the relocation of a number of poles and deviating outside the current licence boundary; and
- amendment to the licence area for the Exmouth region to include a new subdivision.
