Invitation for Public Submissions

APPLICATION TO AMEND HORIZON POWER'S ELECTRICITY INTEGRATED REGIONAL LICENCE 2

The Economic Regulation Authority (Authority) is seeking public comment on an application by Horizon Power to amend its Electricity Integrated Regional Licence (EIRL2).

Horizon Power is seeking to extend its operating boundary to include the following areas:

- Burkes Park - Halls Creek.
- Derby Town Jetty (to include a meter point).
- Broome Port (to include a meter point).
- Karratha Radio Tower (to include a meter point).
- Meekatharra Airport (to include a meter point).
- Camballin region (to include network infrastructure connecting the independent power producer power station).
- Mount Magnet Airport.
- Port Hedland Pretty Pool Sub-Division stage 4.
- South Hedland (to include Fortescue Metals Group facilities).
- Karratha (to include the Nickel precinct sub-division, Pluto facilities and Oceanic facility).
- Derby (to include poles relocated outside the current boundary).
- Exmouth (to include a new sub-division).
