Invitation for Public Submissions on Application to Renew Gas Trading Licence GTL9

ALINTA SALES PTY LTD

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application submitted by Alinta Sales Pty Ltd to renew their gas trading licence GTL9 to sell gas to small use distribution connected customers in the Coastal, Great Southern and Goldfields-Esperance supply areas of Western Australia. Alinta Sales Pty Ltd's current licence is due to expire on 30 June 2010.

The Authority is responsible for licensing gas supply services in Western Australia (under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*) and must take all reasonable steps to decide on the application within 90 days of it being made.

The renewal of a licence is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so, as well as being satisfied that the applicant:

- a) has, and is likely to retain; or
- b) will acquire within a reasonable time after the renewal, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised, or to be authorised, by the licence.
