# Proposed Revised Access Arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline

## **ISSUES PAPER**

The Economic Regulation Authority has published an <u>issues paper</u> on the proposed revised access arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (**DBNGP**).

On 1 April 2010, DBNGP (WA) Transmission Pty Ltd (**DBP**), as the operator and complying service provider of the DBNGP, submitted proposed revisions to the access arrangement on its own behalf and on behalf of DBNGP (WA) Nominees Pty Ltd.

This issues paper has been prepared to assist interested parties in preparing submissions. The paper is not intended to be an exhaustive review of the proposed revised access arrangement for the DBNGP, or the matters that the Authority will address when making a draft decision on whether to approve or not approve the revised access arrangement.

The Authority issued a <u>notice</u> on 14 April 2010, advising of the receipt of DBP's proposed revised access arrangement and invited submissions from interested parties.

The proposed revised access arrangement, access arrangement information and related documents are available on the Authority's <u>website</u>.
