Invitation for Public Submissions – Second Round

AMENDMENT TO WATER CORPORATION'S OPERATING LICENCE 32

On 20 May 2010, the Economic Regulation Authority published a [notice](#) inviting public submissions on an [application](#) by the Water Corporation (**Corporation**) to amend its Water Services Operating Licence 32. The Corporation is seeking approval to extend its potable and non potable water and sewerage operating areas to match the State's controlled area boundaries.

The Authority extended the period for public submissions following a request for an extension and submissions closed on Thursday, 1 July 2010.

Three submissions were received and can be viewed on the Authority's [website](#). Some key issues were raised in one of the submissions, in particular whether:

- an amendment application was subject to financial and technical assessment;
- the request was against current government policy on water licence operating areas; and
- the expansion would be anti-competitive.

Interested parties are invited to review the submissions received and make submissions in print and electronic form on the issues raised relative to the Water Corporation's application by **4:00 pm (WST) on Monday, 16 August 2010**.

Any claim of confidentiality will be considered in accordance with the provisions of Section 55 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*.

The publication of a submission on the Authority's website shall not be taken as indicating that the Authority has knowledge either actual or constructive of the contents of a particular submission and, in particular, whether the submission in whole or part contains information of a confidential nature and no duty of confidence will arise for the Authority.
