Invitation for Public Submissions

APPLICATION FOR ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION LICENCE – KARARA POWER PTY LTD

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application submitted by Karara Power Pty Ltd for an electricity transmission licence in the South West Interconnected System.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004 (Act)*, the Authority is responsible for licensing electricity supply services in Western Australia and must take all reasonable steps to reach a decision within 90 days of receiving the application.

Approval of the application is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to issue the licence. The Authority is required to take into consideration the matters listed in Section 8(5) of the Act when making this assessment.

The Authority must also be satisfied that the applicant has the financial and technical capacity to undertake the proposed activities.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions in print and electronic form on the application by **4:00 pm (WST) on Wednesday, 25 August 2010**.
