## Invitation for Public Submissions

### APPLICATION FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATION LICENCE – TIWEST PTY LTD

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application submitted by Tiwest Pty Ltd (**Tiwest**) for an Electricity Generation Licence to supply customers within the South West Interconnected System.

Tiwest and Verve Energy (**Verve**) have reached an agreement for the sale of Verve's KMK Cogeneration Facility to Tiwest Pty Ltd.

Tiwest's application will be considered in conjunction with Verve Energy's recent application for an amendment to its electricity generation licence EGL7 to remove coverage of the KMK Cogeneration Facility from its licence area.

The Authority is responsible for licensing electricity supply services in Western Australia (under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*) and must take all reasonable steps to decide on the application within 90 days of it being made.

The issuing of a licence is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so if it is satisfied that the applicant:

- a) has, and is likely to retain; or
- b) will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain, the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised, or to be authorised, by the licence.
