Invitation for Public Submissions

WESTNET RAIL - OVERPAYMENT RULES AND COSTING PRINCIPLES

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on the revised <u>Overpayment</u> Rules and <u>Costing Principles</u> proposed by railway owner WestNet Rail (**WNR**) for its railway network.

These documents are available on the Authority's website in clean and marked-up versions.

Costing Principles establish a basis for the Authority to determine upper and lower cost bounds for each route section for price negotiations associated with access agreements made under the *Railways (Access) Code 2000* (**Code**).

Overpayment Rules establish a basis for the railway owner to reimburse operators in the event that total revenue earned on a particular route section exceeds total costs attributable to that route section. The Overpayment Rules apply only to operators who are provided with access under the Code.

Pursuant to WNR's current approved Overpayment Rules and Costing Principles, the Authority is required to commence a review of these two Part 5 instruments in October 2010. WNR submitted its proposed revised Overpayment Rules and Costing Principles to the Authority on 30 September 2010.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions in print and electronic form on WNR's Overpayment Rules and Costing Principles by 4:00 pm (WST) on Tuesday, 2 November 2010.
