

# Decision on Amendment to Water Supply Operating Licence No.39

## DECISION

1. The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) has approved an amendment to Operating Licence 39 (Shire of Denmark). The amendment:
  - a) Indicates that clause 4.5 and 4.6 are “Not applicable”.
  - b) Removes the words “and Sewerage Services” from the sub-title in Schedule 2.
2. This licence amendment was made pursuant to section 31 of the *Water Services Licensing Act 1995 (Act)*.

## REASONS

1. The Shire of Denmark provides non-potable water supply only under its operating licence.
2. Clauses 4.5 and 4.6 of the licence refer to the provision of sewerage services and these clauses should be listed as “Not applicable”.
3. The sub-title in Schedule 2 of the Shire of Denmark’s Water Services Operating Licence 39 includes a reference to sewerage services.
4. Section 31 of the Act sets out the factors governing the Authority’s decision to initiate a licence amendment.
5. As this is a minor amendment, the Authority is not required to seek public submissions on the amendment.
6. The Shire of Denmark has advised it agrees to the amendment.
7. The Authority will publish notice of its approval of the amendment in the *Government Gazette* as soon as is practicable.
