New Facilities Investment Test Application for Transmission Works to Connect Collgar Windfarm

DRAFT DETERMINATION

The Economic Regulation Authority has released its [draft determination](#) on Western Power's application for a new facilities investment test for proposed transmission works to connect Collgar Windfarm to the South West Interconnected Network. The application was submitted under section 6.71 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*.

The Authority's draft determination is to not approve Western Power's application for the reason that Western Power's total forecast new facilities investment of \$21.7 million (of which Western Power claimed that \$13.9 million met the new facilities investment test) potentially exceeds the amount that would be invested by a service provider efficiently minimising costs.
