## DAMPIER TO BUNBURY NATURAL GAS PIPELINE: PROPOSED REVISED ACCESS ARRANGEMENT

### AMENDED REVISED ACCESS ARRANGEMENT PROPOSAL

DBNGP (WA) Transmission Pty Limited (**DBP**) has lodged its response to the Authority's draft decision on the proposed revised access arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (**DBNGP**) issued on 14 March 2011.

The documents submitted by DBP are:

- DBP Submission 47: Revised Access Arrangement Proposal;
- Amended Revised Access Arrangement (clean and marked-up versions);
  - Terms and Conditions; and
  - DBNGP Description of the gas transmission system.
- Amended Revised Access Arrangement Information (clean and marked-up versions)

DBP also provided a confidential version of DBNGP's model and has advised that a public version will be available after Easter. DBP has also advised that it will provide the ERA with 10 supporting submissions as soon as possible and no later than 20 May 2011.

The National Gas Rules require the Authority to allow a period for public submissions of at least 20 business days commencing from the date a service provider is required to lodge its response to the Authority's draft decision. As previously advised on 14 March 2011, the submission date for interested parties to make submissions on the Authority's draft decision is 4:00pm (WST) 20 May 2011.

The Authority notes that the further submissions from DBP will arrive during the public consultation period. The Authority will endeavour to make the submissions public on the Authority's [website](#) as soon as they are available.
