Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline: Proposed Revised Access Arrangement

DISCLOSURE OF TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT REPORT

The Economic Regulation Authority has today published a technical assessment report in respect of the Proposed Revised Access Arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline. The report has been released in a redacted form and is available on the Authority's <u>website</u>.

BACKGROUND

DBNGP (WA) Transmission Pty Ltd (**DBP**) submitted its revised access arrangement proposal for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline on 1 April 2010. The Authority engaged Halcrow Pacific Pty Ltd to provide technical services in support of the assessment of the DBP proposal. The assessment was conducted under the National Gas Law and the National Gas Rules, implemented under the *National Gas Access (WA) Act 2009*.

Proposed revised access arrangement

The Authority made its draft decision on DBP's proposed revised access arrangement for the DBNGP on 14 March 2011. DBP submitted its amended revised access arrangement proposal on 18 April 2011 and public submissions are due on 20 May 2011. The relevant documents can be found on the Authority's website.

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
