Griffin Power 2 Pty Ltd

APPLICATION FOR ELECTRICITY RETAIL LICENCE

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application submitted by Griffin Power 2 Pty Ltd (Griffin Power 2) for an electricity retail licence to supply large use customers within the South West Interconnected System.

The Authority is responsible for licensing electricity supply services in Western Australia (under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*) and must take all reasonable steps to decide on the application within 90 days of it being made.

The issuing of a licence is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so if it is satisfied that the applicant:

- a) has, and is likely to retain; or
- b) will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain, the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised, or to be authorised, by the licence.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions in print and electronic form on the Application by **4:00 pm (WST) on Thursday, 9 June 2011**.
