## Retail Energy Market Company Rule Changes C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S, C04/11R and C05/11R

### DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (Authority) has approved five amendments to the Retail Energy Market Company's (REMCo) Retail Market Scheme (Scheme).

Under Part 2B of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* (Act), the Authority is responsible for the economic regulation of the Western Australian gas retail market scheme which includes approval of amendments to the retail market scheme.

REMCo submitted to the Authority for approval five rule changes, proposing amendments to two components of its Scheme, the Specification Pack and the Retail Market Rules.

On 26 July 2011, the Authority approved Rule Change C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S, C04/11R and C05/11R on the basis that these rule changes are non-substantial, are administrative in nature and will have no impact on whether the Scheme will comply with the Act.

Rule Changes C01/11S, C02/11S, C03/11S, C04/11R and C05/11R are to take effect on 1 August 2011.
