APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE NON-STANDARD AGREEMENT

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved amendments to the Busselton Water Board (t/a Busselton Water) non-standard agreement. The amendments clarify the fact that any non-potable water supplied under the agreement is not fit for human consumption and does not meet the Australian Drinking Water Guidelines (2004).

Busselton Water holds a water services operating licence. The licence allows Busselton Water to enter into an agreement with a customer to provide water services that exclude, modify or restrict the terms and conditions of the licence if the agreement that is used has been approved by the Authority.

The Authority has reviewed the minor amendments proposed by Busselton Water and approved these amendments.
