Alinta Sales Pty Ltd (t/a Alinta Energy)

GAS STANDARD FORM CONTRACT

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Alinta Sales Pty Ltd's (t/a Alinta Energy) proposed replacement standard form contract for the supply of gas to small use customers.

Alinta Energy proposes to amend the confidentiality and privacy provisions of its gas standard form contract. In addition, Alinta Energy proposes a number of amendments to its standard form contract to comply with the *Energy Coordination (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2004*.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, the Authority must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, the Act, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the gas trading licence.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions on Alinta Energy's proposed replacement gas standard form contract by **4:00 pm (WST) on Thursday, 20 December 2012**.

Any claim of confidentiality will be considered in accordance with the provisions of Section 55 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*.

The publication of a submission on the Authority's website shall not be taken as indicating that the Authority has knowledge either actual or constructive of the contents of a particular submission and, in particular, whether the submission in whole or part contains information of a confidential nature and no duty of confidence will arise for the Authority.
