Amendments to the REMCo Retail Market Scheme

DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) has approved amendments to the Retail Energy Market Company's (**REMCo**) Retail Market Scheme (**Scheme**), providing for the operation of the Western Australian Gas Retail Market.

Among other things, the Scheme comprises: the Specification Pack (**Spec Pack**) and the FRC Hub Operational Terms and Conditions. The Spec Pack includes a series of documents that define how participants interact with market systems and other participants' systems. The FRC Hub is the information system for transmission of messages under the rules, and is owned by the Australian Energy Market Operator (**AEMO**). The FRC Hub Operational Terms and Conditions provide the terms for how participants must operate when connecting to, and issuing or receiving transactions via the FRC Hub.

Recently, AEMO approved upgrades to its FRC Hub, the majority of which were to the FRC Hub Operational Terms and Conditions.

Rule Change proposal C02/15S proposed minor documentation changes to the Spec Pack documents to align them with the upgrades already approved for the FRC Hub.

REMCo submitted Rule Change proposal C02/15S to the ERA for approval.

The ERA has approved the amendments to the Spec Pack, which will take effect from 30 June 2015.
