## Consultation on electricity generation licence application

## MERREDIN SOLAR FARM NOMINEE PTY LTD

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) is seeking public comment on an electricity generation licence application from Merredin Solar Farm Nominee Pty Ltd.

Merredin Solar Farm will generate electricity from solar photovoltaic arrays and connect with the South-West Interconnected System. The generation plant is south of Merredin, 260 kilometres east of Perth.

The generation capacity is 100 megawatts. Generators with a capacity over 30 megawatts require a licence.

A summary of the licence application is available on the ERA website.

The grant of a licence is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain; or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

The ERA invites interested parties to make public submissions on the licence application by 16:00 (WST) on 9 November 2017. Please send submissions to the ERA marked for the attention of the Assistant Director Utility Services Regulation:
