# **A-Star Electricity Pty Ltd**

#### 2017 PERFORMANCE AUDIT

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) has published the 2017 performance <u>audit</u> report and post-audit implementation <u>plan</u> for A-Star Electricity Pty Ltd's (**A-Star**) electricity retail licence ERL21.

### ERA's response to the audit

The ERA considers A-Star has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence. The audit identified relatively minor non-compliances covering administrative matters.

The ERA has decided to increase the period covered by the next audit from 36 months to 48 months. The next audit will cover 1 December 2017 to 30 November 2021, with the report due by 28 February 2022.

#### Background to the ERA's decision

#### **Audit ratings and recommendations**

The auditor's assessment of the 204 licence obligations applicable to A-Star's electricity retail licence found:

- 84 obligations were rated A1 (adequate controls, compliant);
- three obligations were rated B2 (generally adequate controls, non-compliant with minor impact);
- one obligation was rated A/NR (adequate controls, compliance not assessed);<sup>1</sup> and
- 116 obligations were rated NP/NR (controls and compliance were not assessed).

The audit identified three non-compliances, which are considered to be minor administrative issues: obligations 124 and 306 (late submission to the ERA of A-Star's annual compliance report for 2017) and obligation 292 (Code of Conduct not available on A-Star's website).

One non-compliance (obligation 292) was resolved during the audit period and requires no further action.

#### Post-audit implementation plan

A-Star has provided a post-audit implementation plan for the remaining two non-compliances (obligations 124 and 306). The expected completion date for both non-compliances is 30 June 2018.

## A-Star has ceased supplying customers

On 23 May 2016, A-Star advised the ERA that it would be exiting the electricity retail market until prices return to a financially viable level (but would retain its licence).

On 1 June 2016, A-Star's customers transferred to other retailers, including AER Retail Pty Ltd (an affiliated company). Both A-Star and AER Retail Pty Ltd are owned by Luca Castelli Pty Ltd.
