COVID-19 pandemic – ERA feedback on regulatory activities and actions proposed by AEMO under Wholesale Electricity Market Rules

Thank you for your letter dated 24 April 2020 concerning AEMO's review of its regulatory activities under the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
