### Submissions Received on Western Power's Revised Forecasts

Western Power provided revised forecasts of its new facilities investment on 26 September 2006. The information included forecasts of both new facilities investment and non-capital costs for Western Power's South West Interconnected Network (SWIN).

Western Power's new forecasts provide for an additional \$63.7 million of new facilities investment and \$23.7 million of non capital costs between 2006/07 and 2008/09. In addition, Western Power has identified further probable increases in new facilities investment that were not included in the most recent forecasts.

The Western Power response also included a proposal to amend the operation of the investment adjustment mechanism in the proposed access arrangement.

On the 6 October 2006 the Authority issued a notice which invited submissions from interested parties in relation to Western Power's submission supporting its revised expenditure forecasts and its proposal to amend the operation of the proposed investment adjustment mechanism.
