Authority Submission on the Report of the Joint Working Group on Natural Gas Supply

Ministerial Council on Energy: Energy Market Reform Bulletin No. 106

The Economic Regulation Authority has made a submission to the Ministerial Council on Energy (MCE) on the report issued by the Joint Working Group on Natural Gas Supply.

The report identified and addressed issues that may affect Australia's ability to realise the twin goals of becoming one of the world's leading liquefied natural gas exporters while ensuring the long-term supply of gas for domestic users. With the rapid growth of the LNG export market and moves by State and Territory Governments to increase Australia's percentage of gas-fired power generation as part of the national greenhouse response, the future demand and supply of gas for domestic use has emerged as a high-priority issue.

Stakeholder feedback was sought by the MCE to further inform the work of the Ministerial Council in addressing the issues raised in the working group's report.
