2008/09 Price List Determination

The Authority has approved Western Power's 2008/09 price list for the South West Interconnected Network.

The new prices, which come into effect on 1 July 2008, are available on the Authority's [web site](#).

The company submitted its proposed 2008/09 prices for the Authority's approval, under Chapter 8 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*, on 21 April 2008.

The changes in individual reference tariff charges (from those established for 2007/08) are within the range of CPI plus or minus five per cent, as allowed under the access arrangement.

The changes comprise increases of:

- between 3.9 and 7.8 per cent for distribution reference tariffs; and
- between 6.0 and 7.8 per cent for transmission reference tariffs.

These increases will not affect retail electricity prices for residential and small business customers, which are fixed by the Western Australian Government.

In approving the submission, the Authority found the proposed prices complied with the price control and pricing methods set out in the access arrangement for the South West Interconnect Network.
