### Invitation for Public Submissions

### Application Received for Gas Trading Licence

The Economic Regulation Authority is assessing an application from Perth Energy Pty Ltd for a licence to trade gas throughout Western Australia.

The company made the application on 3 June 2009.

The Authority is responsible for licensing gas supply services in Western Australia (under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*) and must take all reasonable steps to decide on the application within 90 days of it being made.

This is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so if it is satisfied that the applicant:

- a) has, and is likely to retain; or
- b) will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised, or to be authorised, by the licence.

Submissions on the licence amendments are invited from all interested parties and must be received by **4.00pm Friday 3 July 2009 WST**. Submissions should be in both written and electronic format and directed to:
