APPROVAL OF REPLACEMENT GAS STANDARD FORM CONTRACT

The Economic Regulation Authority has <u>approved</u> the replacement standard form contract for the supply of gas to small use customers submitted by WorleyParsons Asset Management Pty Ltd (WorleyParsons).

The Authority requested that WorleyParsons review its standard form contract to ensure compliance with the requirements of the new Australian Consumer Law and the current versions of the Gas Marketing Code of Conduct and the Compendium of Gas Customer Licence Obligations (Gas Customer Code).

WorleyParsons completed its review and requested that the Authority approve the replacement standard form contract. In accordance with the Authority's <u>Public Consultation Guidelines for Electricity</u>, <u>Gas and Water Licences and Electricity</u> & <u>Gas Standard Form Contracts</u>, the Authority has provided a 15 day public consultation period. There were no submissions received by the closing date of 21 September 2011.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, the Authority must not approve a replacement standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the licence.
