Consultation on gas trading licence application

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Regen Power Pty Ltd's application for a gas trading licence to supply residential and small use business customers in the coastal supply area.^{1, 2}

As part of the application, Regen Power has submitted a standard form contract for the ERA's approval. A summary of the <u>licence application</u> is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licence is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain, or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

The ERA must also have regard to the matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the licence application.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Monday, 13 June 2022.
