Segregation arrangements

The Public Transport Authority (PTA) has submitted its <u>segregation arrangements</u> to the Economic Regulation Authority, as required by section 29 of the *Railways (Access) Act 1998*.

The Act requires that a railway owner make arrangements to segregate its access-related functions from its other functions, and have appropriate controls and procedures to ensure that the measures in place operate effectively and are complied with. Access-related functions are the functions involved in arranging the provisions of access to railway infrastructure under the Code.

The PTA has made changes to its segregation arrangements, including:

- Updating Code-defined terms, for example "Operator" to "Access Holder".
- An addition to section 1.2, which states that the segregation arrangements are relevant only to the portion of the Network to which access is requested by Access Seekers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the PTA's proposed segregation arrangements.
