Breach reporting form

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) collects personal information through this form, including your name, contact details and any other information you provide, for the purpose of receiving, assessing and investigating suspected breaches of the ESM Rules, GSI Rules or Pilbara Networks Rules, including self-reported breaches.

The ERA collects this information so that it can:

- assess and investigate suspected breaches of the relevant market and network rules
- communicate with the reporting party about the suspected breach
- carry out its compliance, monitoring and enforcement functions.

Information submitted in a suspected breach report will not be disclosed unless disclosure is required or authorised by law or under the relevant Rules, or permission has been obtained from the information provider. Where information is used in compliance reporting or regulatory publications, personal or confidential information will be handled in accordance with ERA's Confidentiality information and Privacy Policies.

Confidential or commercially sensitive information should be clearly identified by the reporting party so the ERA can assess and protect it in accordance with its confidentiality and privacy obligations.

If you choose not to provide the requested information, the ERA may be unable to assess or investigate the suspected breach.
