Bluewaters Power 1 Pty Ltd

Licence renewal application – Invitation for public submissions

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Bluewaters Power 1 Pty Ltd's application to renew its [electricity retail licence ERL12](#), which is due to expire on 13 August 2026.

ERL12 authorises Bluewaters to sell electricity to large use customers in the South West Interconnected System.¹ Bluewaters does not supply electricity to residential customers.

A licence may be renewed only if the ERA is satisfied that:

- the renewal is not contrary to the public interest, and
- the applicant has and is likely to retain, or will acquire within a reasonable time after the renewal and is then likely to retain, the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.²

When considering the renewal application, the ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the licence renewal application.

Submissions close 4:00pm (WST) Friday, 5 June 2026.
