EDL Pilbara Pty Ltd

2025 performance audit

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the 2025 performance audit report for [EDL Pilbara Pty Ltd's](#) electricity retail licence ERL16.

EDL Pilbara, through relevant subsidiaries, owns and operates a liquefied natural gas (LNG) facility at the Maitland Industrial Estate in the Pilbara, approximately 20 kilometres south-west of Karratha. The facility was originally designed to service EDL's gas fired power station in the Kimberley region. However, as the LNG facility's electricity generation capacity exceeds EDL's needs, EDL Pilbara supplies electricity under ERL16 to Supagas, co-located on the facility's leasehold land.

The ERA's decision

The ERA considers that EDL Pilbara has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence and decided to maintain the audit period at 60 months. The next audit will cover the period 1 September 2025 to 31 August 2030, with the report due to be provided by 31 December 2030.

Audit findings

The audit of the 12 licence obligations applicable to EDL Pilbara found one minor non-compliance due to EDL Pilbara submitting its 2024 annual compliance report late.

As the auditor did not make any recommendations, a post-audit implementation plan was not required.
