Licence amendment application – Invitation for submissions

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application from Eglinton Village Energy Pty Ltd (EV-Energy) to amend its electricity distribution licence EDL10 and retail licence ERL33. The amendment is to add three new locations to the existing licence area to allow EV-Energy to construct and operate distribution systems and to retail electricity at three new land developments.

The distribution systems are part of microgrids that EV-Energy will construct at the Muchea Industrial Park, Busselton Gateway Airport Industrial Park and Busselton Home HQ. The electricity will be solar-generated and sold to commercial and industrial customers at the land developments.

EV-Energy's current licence area covers the Eglinton Village development where it supplies electricity to residential and commercial customers.

When considering the amendment application, the ERA must be satisfied that the amendment would not be contrary to the public interest. The ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the amendment application.
