Proposed metering documents submitted for Ocean Reef Renewable Energy and Eglinton Village Energy Consultation

Ocean Reef Renewable Energy and Eglinton Village Energy have submitted proposed metrology procedures and model service level agreements to the Economic Regulation Authority for approval.

Ocean Reef Renewable Energy is the licenced distribution network service provider for Ocean Reef Marina.¹ Eglinton Village Energy is the licenced distribution network service provider for a microgrid in Eglinton, Muchea Industrial Park, Busselton Gateway Airport Industrial Park and Busselton Home HQ.²

The documents are required under the *Electricity Industry (Metering) Code 2012*. The metrology procedure provides guidance on the provision, installation and maintenance of metering equipment connected to the network. The model service level agreement details the metering services that a network operator must provide and the terms and conditions, including applicable charges.
