Western Power invites submissions on proposed Baldivis zone substation

Western Power has invited submissions on its proposal to build a new electricity zone substation in Baldivis to meet future demand. Details about the proposed substation can be found on the <u>Western Power website</u>.

Under the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*, Western Power is required to advise the ERA about major augmentations to its network. It must also consult with the public and interested parties.

The public is invited to make submissions to Western Power regarding alternative options or opinions on the proposed substation.

As part of this process, Western Power is hosting community drop-in sessions and an online stakeholder forum. Details, including how to register, can be found on <u>Western Power's website</u>.

Following the consultation process, Western Power must consider the views and alternative options in the submissions it receives. Western Power will then submit a major augmentation proposal to the ERA who will determine whether the regulatory test prescribed in Chapter 9 of the Access Code has been satisfied.
